Mike's daughter Courtney (19yrs) has the life shortening disease CF. She is the oldest of 6 local children and first to transition to adult care. Much work needs to be done to make this transition smoother and provide a more positive environment for them to find work. This complicated condition needs a much more collaborative approach between families, local health, social and family support services. CF Guernsey wants to drive these improvements in communication.



Tim's candid, authentic and humorous speeches are thoroughly engaging, thought-provoking and live a long time in the memory.
