We hold first name, surname, email address and phone number, plus a note of which area of our work is of interest, on a password-protected Excel spreadsheet. We use the Mailchimp platform to distribute our mailings by transferring names and email addresses from the spreadsheet. Mailchimp's privacy policy can be downloaded from mailchimp.com. Our mailings
